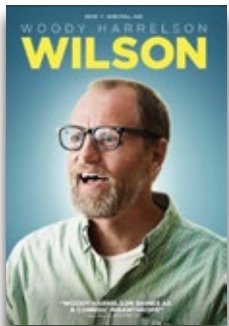

Red, White and Blue Street Party Tuesday, July 4th

Solivita night skies will be shining brightly with the best private fireworks display in Central Florida! In addition to fireworks, there will be food trucks, several cash-only bars, a frozen (cold) patriotic T-shirt Contest at 7:30pm by the Pro Shop stage, bounce houses for the kids, a craft booth, and street entertainers including: face painting, balloon artist, a strolling magician/juggler and music by DJ John, the *High Octane Band* and *Somewhere In Time*. Fireworks can be best viewed either on the bridge or behind the Waterfront Gallery buildings. **Event is complimentary starting at 6pm in the Village Center from the Ballroom to the Pro Shop. FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT 9PM (COULD BE DELAYED DUE TO RAIN).** Guests of all ages are welcome.

Notices: There is no seating provided for the fireworks display, so bring your own chair. Chairs will NOT be permitted to be removed from inside any building. Golf cart parking is permitted on the grass by the Ballroom. Please, no tents, coolers or pets are permitted. Fireworks display may be delayed due to the weather.
