- The main ticket sale will be **MONDAY, OCTOBER 2ND** in the **BALLROOM** from 9am-10am for **October and November tickets**. **Doors open at 8am**. Afterwards, tickets will be sold at the Lifestyles office Monday-Friday from 9am-5pm. Clubs selling tickets are also to remain until 10am.
- All residents will need to present their resident ID badges.
- Maximum of 4 tickets can be purchased per resident, per event, unless otherwise stated.
- You can pay by check made payable to **Avatar Properties Inc. Solivita Club**, credit/debit card, or cash (**EXACT CASH AMOUNT ONLY**).
- The first month a Lifestyles event goes on sale, tickets are for residents only (unless otherwise specified). After this, if the event is not sold out, adult guests are welcome and residents can purchase any remaining ticket(s).
- Ticket(s) can be returned for **CREDIT ONLY**; no credit will be given less than 5 days prior to the event.

Jazz in the Garden

LIMITED TICKETS

The Ballroom will be transformed when you walk on the green pathway and enter into the four lush gardens twinkling with lights. You will delight in the ambiance of crickets chirping in the trees, a flowing water fountain and the sweet soothing sound of jazz performed by the *Bobby Tate Band*. Once you are seated, you will be treated to family style hors d'oeuvres including grilled island shrimp served on an avocado salad and a basket of assorted crisps and spreads including tomato jam, pesto ricotta and an herb cheese. The salad course is a roasted butternut squash and apple combined with toasted quinoa, dried cranberries, candied pecans and mixed greens served with a cranberry vinaigrette and a glass of Pinot Gris. The main entrée is a choice of: (B) Hanger steak served medium and smothered with creamy peppercorn sauce paired with a glass of Cabernet OR (S) Baked seafood stuffed salmon topped with a citrus beurre blanc paired with a glass of Riesling. Each entrée will be served with garlic whipped potatoes and fall vegetables. The pièce de résistance is the decadent combination of chocolate and peanut butter mousse served with pretzel brittle and cranberry compote, paired with a glass of Prosecco. Soda or sparkling wine is available as a non-alcoholic alternative. Cocktail attire is required. **Ballroom doors open at 6:30pm and dinner begins at 7pm. \$65 per person. Adult guests welcome.**
